

Let's talk about Order 66...

"The time has come. Execute Order 66. It will be done, my lord."

Have you ever seen *Star Wars*? Well, if you have, chances are you are familiar with the infamous Order 66 scene. For first time viewers, this scene might not make much sense. You may be wondering, what is Order 66? Why did the Clones suddenly turn on the Jedi? Glad you asked. Today, we will be taking a deep dive into the mysterious nature of Order 66 and The Clone Wars.

To start things off, we must talk about the beginning of the conflict that led up to the execution of Order 66. Thousands of years before the events of the Star Wars films, the Jedi and Sith orders were at war with each other. Eventually, the Jedi Order came out victorious in the war, and it was long believed that the Sith were extinct. Unbeknownst to both the Jedi and the Galaxy, the Sith lived on for many years and were plotting their revenge on the Jedi and their plan for Galactic Dominance.

The Sith Lord Darth Sidious began a career as a Senator in the Galactic Senate, with his end-goal to become Emperor of the Galaxy and destroy all of the Jedi. 

Star Wars: The Bad Batch is finally returning for a second season in January, 2023. With the release almost upon us, let's talk about the Bad Batch themselves in all their glory.

The Bear That Fought A War

Most of the Time, when you think of soldiers, you think of strong men with guns. But it hasn't always been like this. Sure, there have been a multitude of female soldiers - but what this story talks about is the most unique soldier of all time.

A Railway Station in Hamadan

In the spring of 1942, the Anders' Army, the Polish Armed Forces in the East, left the Soviet Union for Iran. They were accompanied by thousands of Polish civilians that were deported from eastern Poland following the Soviet Invasion of Poland in 1939. At a railroad station in Hamadan, Iran, on 8 April 1942, Polish soldiers encountered a young Iranian boy who had found a bear whose mother had been shot by hunters. One of the civilians that accompanied them, Irena Bokiewicz, the great niece of General Boleslaw Wieniawa-Dlugoszowski, was very taken by the bear. She prompted Lt. Anatol Tarnowiecki to buy the bear, which then spent the next three months under Irena's care in a Polish refugee camp near Tehran. In August he was donated to the 2nd Transport Company, later the 22nd Artillery Supply Company, and was named Wojtek by the soldiers - the diminutive form of Wojciech, or "happy warrior".

Private Wojtek

During his time in the 22nd Company, he moved to Iraq and through the Levant and Egypt. He enjoyed smoking (or eating) cigarettes, drinking coffee in the mornings, and wrestling with the soldiers. He was even taught to salute. He was an attraction to soldiers and civilians alike, and became a mascot for all the units stationed nearby.

From Egypt, the Polish II Corps was reassigned to fight alongside the British Eighth Army in the Italian campaign. British transport ship regulations prohibited mascots or pet animals, so Wojtek was officially enlisted in the Polish Army as a Private and was listed among soldiers in the 22nd Artillery Supply Company. His assigned caretakers were Henryk Zacharewicz and Dymitr Szawlugo.

Since he was an enlisted soldier with his own playbook, rank, and serial number, he lived with the other men in tents or in a special wooden crate that was transported by truck. During the Battle of Monte Cassino, Wojtek helped his unit to convey ammunition by carrying 100 lb (45 kg) of 25-pound artillery shells. He never dropped one of them. While this story did generate controversy over its accuracy, there is at least one account in existence of a British soldier recalling seeing a bear carrying crates of ammo. Wojtek mimicked the soldiers: he saw men lifting crates, and he would copy them. He could carry crates that would normally require four men, and he would then stack them onto trucks or other ammunition boxes. His service at Monte Cassino earned him the rank of Corporal. The 22nd Company adopted a depiction of a bear carrying an artillery shell in recognition of Wojtek's popularity.

The Edinburgh Zoo

After the end of WWII in 1945, Wojtek and the rest of the 22nd Company were transported to Berwickshire, Scotland. They were stationed at Winfield Airfield on Sunwick Farm, near the village of Hutton. Wojtek became popular among both local civilians and the press, and the Polish-Scottish Association made him an honorary member. Following demobilization in 1947, Wojtek was given to the Edinburgh Zoo, where he lived for the rest of his life. He was visited by journalists and former Polish soldiers, some of whom tossed him cigarettes to eat, like he did in the Army.


Wojtek died in December 1963, at the age of 21.

NCAA Basketball Preseason Rankings

NCAA Division I men's basketball is mainly known for its tournament accurately dubbed "March Madness." The playoff bracket is very exciting, but the regular season is also as exciting. The preseason rankings of these squads are now revealed.

Gonzaga is at the top of the NCAA rankings ladder. They have an extremely talented team but had some setbacks last year. They lost against ranked opponents Duke and Alabama, dropping them down to the number five spot. Then in the tournament, they advanced to the Sweet 16 only to lose to Arkansas. The Zags are returning six of the top eight scorers from a season ago - among them, two-time All-American Drew Timme and double-digit scorers Julian Strawther and Rasir Bolton.

UNC (University of North Carolina) is second in the preseason. UNC during last season's tournament made a great run from being seeded 8th to making a run to the national championship game. They unfortunately lost that game, but have a great outlook for this season. They have four starters returning to their lineup, among them All-American candidates Armando Bacot and Caleb Love, so unlike other ranked teams, their lineup will most likely be staying the same.

The Houston Cougars are taking the number three spot. They are returning talented scorer Jamal Shead and getting All-American candidate Marcus Sasser back from injury. This provides coach Kelvin Sampson with a talented and experienced core.

Kentucky and Duke wrap up the top five. In the fourth spot, Kentucky has returning CBS Sports National Player of the Year Oscar Tshiebwe and SEC assist-leader Sahvir Wheeler. The Duke Blue Devils are returning Jeremy Roach and pairing him with the top-ranked recruiting class that features three of the best four prospects in the Class of 2022.

Arkansas takes the sixth spot as an underrated team, in my opinion. They did lose almost every meaningful piece from last season's Elite Eight team besides Davonte Davis. They should still be a Final Four contender, thanks in part to the addition of five-star prospects Nick Smith, Anthony Black and Jordan Walsh.

The Kansas Jayhawks are at the eighth spot. Critically, they are returning Jalen Wilson, Dajuan Harris and Joseph Yusefu from a team that won the NCAA Tournament.

Tennessee takes the ninth spot, all thanks to them returning four of the top five scorers. This team last year won the SEC tournament, so they are still a threat to any SEC team.

Auburn is surprisingly at the 14th spot. This team earned the number two spot in last year's tournament and are also bringing back four out of their six top scorers.

For you Virginia fans, your Cavaliers are ranked 16th. They are returning the top seven scorers, from a team that finished 12-8 in the ACC and won two games in the NIT (Not in Tournament).

These rankings will surely get mixed up, but we will see how these top teams handle the pressure.





The 2022 Midterms

On 8 November 2022, midterm elections took place in the United States. The seats up for election included the 34 Class 3 seats of the Senate, all 435 seats of the House of Representatives, and 36 state governorships.

The Senate

The Senate seats up for election this year were last elected in the 2016 general election and will next be elected in the 2028 general election. Seats up for election this year included Pennsylvania, Georgia, and Florida. Most seats claimed victory for the incumbent senator (or the incumbent party if the senator retired). However, the Pennsylvania senate election ended with a seat flip, as Democratic candidate John Fetterman defeated Republican Mehmet Oz in the election to succeed retiring Republican senator Pat Toomey. The other election of interest in the Senate is Georgia, which had no clear winner and set a runoff date for 6 December. The Senate elections ended with Democrats retaining control of the Senate, with either a 50/50 split or a simple Democrat majority, depending on the outcome of the Georgia runoff between Democrat Raphael Warnock and Republican Herschel Walker.

The House

The House of Representatives had all 435 seats up for election. Out of this, there were many retirements, a lot of incumbent victories, and a lot of seat flips. Overall, the Republican Party won the house; However, they will only have a simple majority, not enough congresspeople to do much. The split Congress will most likely lead to struggles for the Democrats to pass legislation in the last two years of Biden's term. The new Speaker of the House will likely be Kevin McCarthy, incumbent floor leader of the House Republicans.

Governorships

36 states had an election for Governor this year. These states include Florida, Maryland, and Pennsylvania. Most states elected their incumbent Governor or ruling party; This included Florida and Texas. Due to the fact Texas has no term limits, the next term will actually be Texan Governor Greg Abbott's third term. Seat flips include Massachusetts, Maryland, and Arizona flipping to the Democrats, and Nevada switching to the Republicans.


